CONFINED SPACES CAN BE DANGEROUS



NEVER Enter A Confined Space Unless You Are Authorized To Do So!

Confined spaces can be dangerous because of:

- 1 Lack of Oxygen
- **2** Deadly Fires
- 3 Toxic Vaport
- **4** Physical Hazards
 - For example: moving parts, falls, and live wires

To protect yourself:

- Learn what confined spaces exist in your facility.
- Don't enter without an approved entry permit.
- Cut off steam, water, heat, gas, and power lines, and remember to use lockout/tagout procedures.
- Wear the PPE you've been given.
- Test for oxygen, combustibility, and toxicity before and after you enter the space.
- Be prepared for hazards and have an escape route.
